

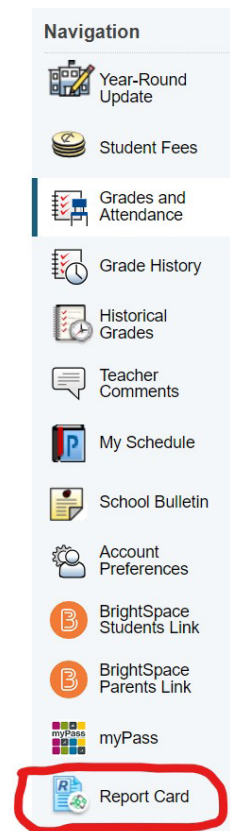
How to access your student's report card on the PowerSchool Parent Portal:

You will need to view the report card in a browser, the PowerSchool App will not work.

Visit <https://powerschool.eips.ca/public/home.html>

Enter your **username and password**. If you do not know this information, please call the school at 780-467-7751 and we will be happy to help you.

Once you are logged in, click on **Report Card** at the very bottom under **Navigation**.



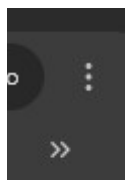
Make sure the correct year is selected in the drop-down menu beside **School Year. 2024-25**

Then click the link to the report card. It should read **Report 1 - 2024-25**.

Note: *The fully supported browsers to view the report card are Chrome (recommended) and Firefox.*

If you need to change the language of the report card, click on the **three vertical dots in the top right-hand corner of the window where you are viewing the report card**.

Scroll down and click on **Translate**. Click on **the three vertical dots** and click **Choose another language**. Use the drop down menu to choose a language and click on it. Then click on **Translate**.



How to read your student's report card:
